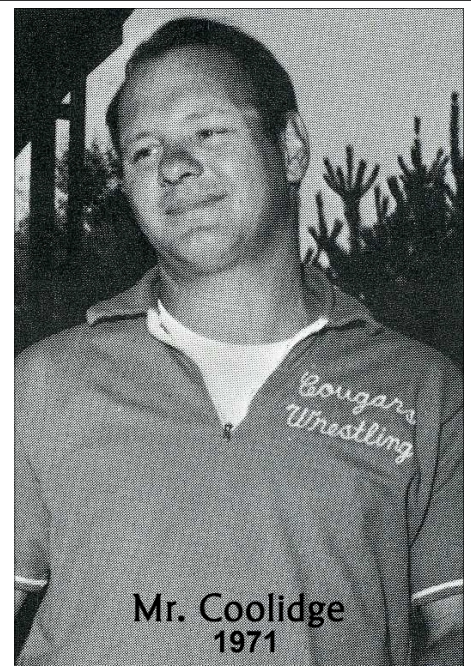
About the profession of teaching I would say that it was really quite enjoyable because all of us love the subject we are teaching and love to impart that to the students.
